Call to Order: The June 23, 2009 Public Hearing to discuss the FY2010 Budget was called to order by Mayor William C. Stewart, Jr. at 6:15 p.m.

Additions or Deletions to Agenda:

1. Cemetery Contract – Greg Scott

Approval of Agenda: Jason Phillips made a motion to approve agenda; Wayne Braswell seconded the motion; motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

- A. Adoption by Resolution of the FY2010 Budget – Mayor Stewart:** Mayor Stewart asked David Jordan to read the resolution. Jason Phillips made a motion to adopt the FY2010 Budget; Kenneth Roach seconded the motion; David Jordan advised he was opposed to any increase to citizens as a result of the non-funding of the Governor's Home Owners Relief Grant. Greg Scott advised Council that we are studying this matter; motion carried 5-0.
- B. Cemetery Contract – Greg Scott:** Greg Scott asked Council approval for him to enter into a Contract with A & A Lawn Service to maintain the cemetery. He also stated that this company had

very good references and that the contract specified what the City desires and can be severed at any time. The contract price is approximately \$27,000.00 per year, which will be funded by a position in the street department that is not going to be replaced. David Jordan made a motion to approve; Wayne Braswell seconded the motion; motion carried 5-0.

Executive Session: Kenneth Roach made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss personnel; Wayne Braswell seconded the motion; motion carried 5-0. Executive session entered at approximately 6:45 p.m.
