CALLED COUNCIL MEETING

Call to Order: The September 29, 2009 Called Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor William C. Stewart, Jr. at 6:30 p.m.

Additions or Deletions to Agenda:

1. Complaint regarding sanitation truck – Keith Turman

Approval of Agenda: Kenneth Roach made a motion to approve the agenda; Wayne Braswell seconded the motion; motion carried 6-0.

New Business:

- A. Complaint Regarding Sanitation Truck – Keith Turman:** Councilman Turman has had a complaint from the hospital regarding the results of cleanup after the City truck compacts the trash. Gloria advised that she and the Mayor had viewed the situation and are studying solutions; right now it seems that the only option is to relocate the dumpsters across the street in their graveled lot. The cost of using other methods to bypass compacting on site would probably be astronomical to the City and the hospital. We will continue to study the situation for the best solution.

Executive Session: A motion to enter executive session to discuss personnel was made by Jason Phillips; motion seconded by Wayne Braswell; motion carried 6-0; executive session entered at 6:40 p.m.

Jason Phillips made a motion to reopen the meeting; motion seconded by Dave Nelson; motion carried 6-0; meeting reopened at 9:12 p.m.

Wayne Braswell made a motion to allow the City Manager to hire Billy Parham as Street/Sanitation Manager with the understanding that Council had four excellent candidates to choose from; Keith Turman seconded the motion; motion carried 6-0.

In other business: Greg Scott, City Manager has been deployed to active duty in the Air Force in support of OIF for up to one year and will continue on a part time basis working actively with the City in the same capacity; he will be here a few days each month and will usually be available by phone and email.

Adjourn: A motion was made by Wayne Braswell to adjourn; motion seconded by Keith Turman; motion carried 6-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:16 p.m.
