



MINUTES
CALLED COUNCIL MEETING
November 24, 2009, 5:15 PM

Call to Order: The November 24, 2009 Called Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor William C. Stewart, Jr. at 5:15 p.m.

Attendance: Mayor William C. Stewart, Jr., Clark Williams, Kenneth Roach, Mayor Pro-Tem Jason Phillips, Keith Turman, Wayne Braswell, Angie Pressley, City Clerk, Gloria and City Manager, Greg Scott via phone.

Executive Session: Wayne Braswell made a motion to enter into executive session to discuss personnel; Kenneth Roach seconded the motion; motion carried 6-0. Executive Session entered at 5:16 pm.

A motion to reopen the meeting was made by Wayne Braswell at 5:47 pm; motion seconded by Kenneth Roach; motion carried 6-0.

Wayne Braswell made a motion to renew the City's present group health insurance plan #H354 with Athens Area Health Plan Select and the City will continue to fund the full premium of \$440.62 per employee, however due to the sizable increase in premium that the City will incur, the dental, life, AD&D, and short-term disability, with MetLife, will now become optional at full cost to the employee of approximately \$54.74; motion seconded by Jason Phillips; motion carried 6-0.

Wayne Braswell made a motion to present a Christmas bonus, for this year only, of \$200.00 to full time employees and \$100.00 to scheduled part-time and part-time employees due to the great job of staying under budget for last fiscal year and in addition cutting the budget for this fiscal year; this benefit will be reviewed and a decision made of presentment and amount, if any, by Mayor and Council annually; motion carried 6-0.

In other Business: Kenneth Roach has had complaints of speeding on Brooks Street and a resident has asked if speed bumps can be put in the area. Discussion held. Council will ask for more police presence in the area and continue to study the situation.

Adjourn: Keith Turman made a motion to adjourn; Wayne Braswell seconded the motion; motion carried 6-0. Meeting adjourned at approximately 6:03 p.m.
