**CALLED COUNCIL MEETING/BUDGET WORK SESSION
MAY 10, 2010, 10:00 AM**

Call to Order: The May 10, 2010 Called Council Meeting/Budget Work Session was called to order by Mayor David L. Jordan at 10:15 am.

Attendance: Mayor David L. Jordan, Larry Bowen, Kenneth Roach, Mayor Pro-Tem Keith Turman, Wayne Braswell, Clark Williams, Matt Fields, City Manager Greg Scott, and City Clerk, Gloria Brown.

Additions or Deletions to Agenda:

1. Signs for advertisement in City Park – Kenneth Roach
2. Reduce time limit to 15 day response on nuisance ordinances – Larry Bowen

Approval of Agenda: Wayne Braswell made a motion to approve; Larry Bowen seconded the motion; motion carried 6-0.

New Business:

- A. Signs for Advertisement in City Park – Kenneth Roach:** Councilman Roach is concerned with the appearance of signs advertising various businesses in the City Park. Donnie Bolemon stated that these have been allowed for up to three weeks only and was trying to keep consistency in the procedure. Discussion held. Kenneth made a motion that there be no freestanding signs in the City Park or City hall other than for City use; more discussion and questions asked. Kenneth Roach withdrew his motion. Further clarification on wording of the motion will be done and brought before Council at the May 11, 2010 regular meeting.
- B. Reduce Time Limit to 15 Day Response on Nuisance Ordinances – Larry Bowen:** Councilman Bowen is requesting the time limit be shortened for people to comply with nuisance ordinances. Discussion held. This will be discussed with the City Attorney and brought before Council at the May 11, 2010 regular meeting.
- C. Budget Work Session:** Greg Scott presented the FY2011 proposed budget and commented on several items. Gloria Brown advised Council of several changes in budgeting procedures for this year. Discussion held and questions asked of various department managers. Council will vote on the FY2011 proposed budget at the May 11, 2010 regular meeting so that proper advertising, public hearing, and adoption by resolution can be done at the June 8, 2010 regular meeting.

In other business: The Franklin County SPLOST meeting was briefly discussed.

Adjourn: Wayne Braswell made a motion to adjourn; Keith Turman seconded the motion; motion carried 6-0. Meeting adjourned at approximately 11:31 am.
